**Patient Information**

The PredictSURE IBD™ test is developed by Predictimmune Ltd who are invested in improving the clinical management of autoimmune diseases.

PredictImmune Ltd. aim to:

- Learn how to improve autoimmune disease management
- Make new discoveries that will deepen our understanding of why some people have a more aggressive disease course than others
- Support healthcare researchers to develop new tests and medicines

If you decide to take part in the PredictSURE IBD™ advanced information programme, your Consultant will record additional demographic and clinical information about you (see "Additional Patient Information" section above), when ordering the test.

Predictimmune will collect, store and analyse your information in an aggregated form, meaning your information will be combined with other people's information, and the resulting assembled data will be used to advance future tests and medicines.

Predictimmune may also share this aggregated information with research groups they have partnered with. The researchers may be from not-for-profit organisations, as well as commercial organisations (those whose aim is to make a profit).

Your information will be collected and stored in a secure data centre in the UK. Its security level meets national data standards. This data is only accessible by authorised Predictimmune personnel. If your data is shared with a partner research group, data transfer and security safeguards will be established and documented in a contract with the research group.

**Importantly, your clinical information will be passed to Predictimmune in a de-identified form, i.e. no personally identifiable information (e.g. your name, NHS number etc.) will be passed to PredictImmune or their partners.**
